

Little Hands on the Farm

The Little Hands on the Farm Exhibit will be returning to the 2010 Utah State Fair. Exhibit hours are 10:00 am to 8:00 pm.

At the start barn, you begin your "visit" to the farm. Put on your apron, grab a basket, we have many products to "harvest". Our first stop is the real grain silo. Scoop up some feed for the animals, put it in your basket. Next stop is the dairy barn. Feed and then milk the cow. Don't forget your carton of milk, add it to your basket. Next pick an apple from the tree in the apple orchard and add it to your basket. Move on to the Garden. Here you can "plant" a seed on one side and "dig" up a vegetable on the other. Make sure to keep that veggie in your basket. Next head over to the tractor shed. "Drive" your basket of goods over to the sheep barn. This sheep needs to be groomed. Take a piece of wool and add it to your basket. Chicken coop is next, gather an egg and add it to your basket. Move on to the farmers market to sell your goods. Drop off each item that you harvested on your visit to the farm. The store clerk will buy your items. Now that you have your Little Hands on the Farm money, you can purchase a real agricultural product from the grocery store. We hope that you begin to understand the connection to agriculture from the farm to the grocery store.
